

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I. Team Staff Requirements

- a. ALL team staff (head coaches, assistant coaches, managers, etc.) are required to complete the following:
 - i. Make Ethical Decisions Multi-Sport Module.
 - ii. Make Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation (Competition-Introduction).
 - iii. Making Headway in Sport Module.
- **II. "NEW" COACHES:** This section is for coaches that have not started the certification process and have not yet completed any of the certification components.




a. Coach Certification Pathway Overview

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b. 12U-16U Age Category: "A" Level Head Coach Requirements


- i. All Head Coaches MUST complete the red highlighted area AND

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c. 12U-16U Age Category: "AA" Level Head Coach Requirements


i. All Head Coaches MUST complete the yellow highlighted areas.



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d. 17U-18U Age Category: "A" Level Head Coach Requirements


i. All Head Coaches MUST complete the yellow highlighted areas.

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- **III. COACHES "IN TRAINING":** This section is for coaches that have completed some components of their certification, but have not yet been designated as certified.
 - a. Coaches that have completed the Development Coach Workshop/Advanced Development Coach Workshop OR the Multi-Sport Modules are designated as Level 1 "in training" or Level 2 "in training".
 - b. Coaches with an "in training" designation need to complete the remaining components to acquire their Development Coach/Advanced Development Coach Certification
 - i. Volleyball Canada e-Modules
 - ii. Development Coach Workshop or Advanced Development Coach Workshop
 - iii. Multi-Sport Modules
 - iv. Make Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation
 - v. Making Head Way in Sport Module
 - vi. Level 1 or Level 2 Portfolio & Evaluation
- IV. "CERTIFIED" COACHES: This section is for coaches that have completed their certification and have been designated as Level 1 Certified or Level 2 Certified.
 a. 2016 Requirements
 - i. 12U-16U Level 1 Certified.
 - ii. 17U-18U Level 2 Certified.
 - b. 2017 Requirements
 - i. Coaches that have their Level 1 or Level 2 Certification may be required to complete additional components for the 2017 club season.

V. Volleyball BC Exemptions (Provincial Championships)

- a. Development Coach
 - i. Coaches must complete one of the following two items:
 - 1. Volleyball Canada e-Modules OR
 - 2. Multi-Sport Modules (Make Ethical Decisions, Planning a Practice & Nutrition).
 - ii. Coaches will only be granted one exemption to complete their Development Coach certification.
- b. Advanced Development Coach
 - i. Coaches must complete one of the following two items:
 - 1. Volleyball Canada e-Modules OR
 - 2. Multi-Sport Modules (Make Ethical Decision, Plan a Practice, Nutrition, Design a Basic Sport Program & Basic Mental Skills).
 - ii. Coaches will only be granted one exemption to complete their Advanced Development Coach certification.

VI. Volleyball Canada Certification Policy (National Championships)

- a. 2016 Requirements
 - i. 12U-16U Age Categories
 - 1. Level 1 Certified OR
 - Volleyball Canada e-Modules, Multi-Sport Modules (Make Ethical Decisions, Plan a Practice & Nutrition), Make Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation AND Making Head Way in Sport Module.
 - ii. 17U-18U Age Categories
 - 1. Level 2 Certified OR
 - Volleyball Canada e-Modules, Multi-Sport Modules (Make Ethical Decisions, Plan a Practice, Nutrition, Design a Basic Sport Program & Basic Mental Skills), Make Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation AND Making Head Way in Sport Module.

VII. Maintenance of Certification

- a. In addition to the required certification components, coaches will also be responsible for maintaining their certification through professional development opportunities. Development coaches will need to acquire 20 professional development points every 5 year period. The number of professional development points required for Advanced Development Coaches is still being determined.
- b. VIII. Frequently Asked Questions

- a. How long does the full certification process take?
 - i. E-Modules: 5-6 hours of online work
 - ii. Development Workshop: 2 days class and court time
 - iii. Advanced Development Workshop: 2 days class and court time
 - iv. Multi-Sport Modules in class, can be done through home study
 - 1. Making Ethical Decision: 3.5 hours
 - 2. Nutrition: 1.5 hours
 - 3. Planning a Practice: 7 hours
 - 4. Designing a Basic Sport Program: 4 hours
 - 5. Basic Mental Skills: 3 hours
 - v. Making Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation: 1.5 hours
 - vi. Making Headway in Sport Module: 2-3 hours of online work
 - vii. Portfolio and Evaluation Requirement: amount of time is dependent on the coaching candidate
