These are the tentative schedule dates for all the competitions for this age group with estimated costs. Not all teams will be going to every tournament. Your specific tournaments will be outlined in the player offer letter. SKY is waiting for final confirmation from VBC on costs and dates.

### Base Fee - Due January 9 - \$470.00

The "Base" fee will include the following:

- Training Sessions (facility cost and equipment)
- Apparel Kit; Backpack, Hoodie, Jersey (x2 for HP Teams), T-Shirts (x2) and Socks (x2)
- Coach's Registration with Volleyball BC
- Coach's Education with Volleyball Canada
- Administration Fees

## **Competition Fee - Due Feb 11**

The "Competition" fee will include the following:

- Volleyball BC Event Fee (each team participates in a variety and number of events)
- Coach's Hotel & Per Diem for out-of-town events

#### **MISCELLANEOUS DETAILS:**

- Practices begin the week of January 3, 2022
- We do not accept requests for practice days or player placements
- Practices will be set after try outs (based on which team you are selected for)
- Fees are based on a roster of 12 players

NEW THIS YEAR- Player hotel rooms are not paid for in fees! The player rooms are blocked off, but it is up to each TEAM to organize and book (and pay for) their own hotel rooms for the athletes for each overnight tournament. Please look to your coach for guidance, and your team manager. It is EXPECTED that the athletes will all stay in the same hotel as the coach for continuous team building and ease of transportation. I will block off rooms at the hotel, but then the responsibility shifts to team level. Why the change this year? To save cost to parents, if you are going to a tournament, your child can stay with you so you're not paying for your room and a portion of the athlete room. If you still want your child to bunk with their team mates and you have a separate room, that is also your choice. If you, as a parent, aren't going to the tournament, it is up to you to make sure your child has a ride to and from AND their accommodations sorted out. Uncertainty due to ever changing covid rules still this year, we felt building the hotel cost into fees wasn't ideal.
